Parental Involvement Education is a two-way process. Your involvement and support is essential in your child's progression. This year we will be providing more opportunities for you to be involved in your child's learning.

Parentpay is our cashless system for paying for trips, swimming, school meals etc. Communication from myself, teachers and school is only sent via Parentpay. Separated parents can both have access to Parentpay. Lunches need to be booked via this system even if your child is in the infants and receives Universal school meals (Rec-Y2).

When using Parentpay please book by 7pm the previous day. Children cannot be accepted into clubs without a completed booking, last year we
